State Rules and Laws

OAR 581-022-2045 mandates that public schools provide comprehensive, age-appropriate prevention education on drugs and alcohol, integrated into the existing curriculum and aligned with state standards. This education, which must be scientifically based, addresses the health, safety, and academic consequences of substance use. The rule emphasizes involving parents in the education process, ensuring they are informed and engaged. Additionally, it requires that teachers and staff responsible for delivering this education receive proper training. Schools must regularly evaluate the effectiveness of their prevention programs and develop policies to reinforce consistent messaging about the dangers of drug and alcohol use. This rule reflects Oregon's commitment to promoting student health and safety through effective substance abuse prevention strategies.

SB 238 (2023) - SECTION 1. As part of the comprehensive alcohol and drug abuse policy and implementation plan described in ORS 336.222, the Oregon Health Authority, State Board of Education and Alcohol and Drug Policy Commission shall collaborate on developing curricula supplements to be implemented by school districts related to: (1) Dangers of synthetic opioids, including fentanyl or any substituted derivative of fentanyl, and counterfeit and fake drugs.

K-8 Instruction

The Adel School District implements McGraw Hill's "The Great Body Shop" for its K-8 curriculum. We support that curriculum with TSEL and Character Strong weekly lessons, community partners such as, School District Nurse and Lake County LEA guest presentations, and other resources such as ODE supported lessons from their website.

Referral Procedures

In a community of 50+/- adults, 10-15 school aged children, and 45 minutes from a town that has resources; Adel staff, students, and stakeholders rely on the School District and ESD staff and their connections and knowledge of services for all situations related to student well being. Because of our size, we are able to communicate face to face with our families and support them with necessary resources, including transportation and internet/technology access. Teachers work closely with the principal and counselor to ensure we have exhausted all resources available.
